Togonon gallery is pleased to present new paintings by Brigid McCabe and Daniel Kim. This is McCabe's third exhibition and Kim's first at Togonon Gallery.

Brigid McCabe's oil paintings, consisting of organic square tessellations that encapsulate tiny figurative elements inside, provide a space where the imagined can exist and the daily inventories of life are examined. In the patterns and routines created from familiar habits, McCabe's works maximize what is apparent and through their properties and intricacies bring meaning to the surface. McCabe obtained her BFA from UC Santa Cruz and her MFA at Boston University. She lives and works in the Bay Area.

Through experimentation with the capabilities of paint on canvas, Kim's interest in the various readings of Beauty is further explored in his new work. Daniel Kim's abstract canvases of obscure subject matter intensify the content, which is made as significant as possible with color, temperature, volume, value, light and different paint application. Kim completed his BFA and MFA at the Art Institute of Chicago. He lives and works in Chicago, Illinois.
